Beech House Social Club Covid Directions.

Welcome. Please read and follow these directions to help the club to be open in these difficult times. We might not have them correct straight away but with your patience and understanding we can have our club up and running safely. Social distancing is an important part of our directions and is for the benefit of everybody staff and members. Please also read the reverse to see our directions.

Strictly Members only (inside & outside)

If you are experiencing any covid symptoms eg, headache, new dry cough or loss of taste and or smell please do not enter for the safety of your fellow members and possible closure of the club.

That any member or members failing to adhere to observe safety measures will result in service not being provided and asked to leave .

Members should be prepared to remove face coverings safely if asked to do so by police officers and staff for the purpose of investigation.

Also police and the local authorities have the powers to enforce requirements in relation to social distancing and may instruct members to disperse, leave an area, issue a fixed penalty notice or take further enforcement action.

There will be no live entertainment along with darts, card games or dominoes. However, background music can be playing but not at a level that people have to raise their voice to be heard.

The club will be cleaned and sanitized each day prior to opening.

The bar is now screened off to protect staff and members and we would prefer to accept contactless payments.

Generally, please be alert to your situation and aware of your surroundings and apply common sense at all times for your own safety and the safety of others.

We have to restrict numbers and will monitor occupancy to ensure social distancing can be maintained and reserve the right to stop entry if this is going to be a problem on the night. Booking a table may have to be introduced if this is a problem. Please bear with us on this and not be offended if we have to refuse you entry if full.

Entrance & Exit. Use the normal front entrance but on leaving please leave via the exit door in the back snooker room. To access the external smoking area please use this route.

Please use the smoking shed exercising social distancing rather that the entrance and exit doors.

There will be hand sanitizing units in the entrance foyer and by the exit door.

Each person must sign in with their name or membership number with contact details (for track and trace if required) and time of entry and exit.

Please do not fetch any of your own food to eat or share with others.

No vaping inside,

There is no standing allowed other than round the first snooker table keeping to current social distancing rules.

Tables have been separated to accommodate social distancing.

Please do not move the tables and chairs they have been placed there for a reason

Customers of 2 different households (including support bubbles) can sit at the same table whilst outside a group of at most six people from any number of households.

Strictly no standing at the bar and please try to refrain from touching or leaning on the bar whilst ordering or leaving items on the bar.

When ordering, service will be from the till end with the queue in front of the bar. Follow the markings.

Whilst queuing please social distance within the markings.

Please observe the length of the queue before deciding to join the queue.

Please return glasses into the glass trays at either end of the bar when reordering or leaving the club and any bottles in the bins provided.

The back snooker room will be available to play snooker but should be aware of people exiting through that area.

Toilet doors will be left open to ensure social distancing can be achieved.

Hand sanitizing units outside each toilet along with soap and water inside to hand wash and cleaning wipes for surfaces where required.

There will be cleaning stations available to sanitize snooker equipment and tables after and before each game or change of players to be used by players.

There will be cleaning stations also for the games machines after and before each player to be used by members.

Cleaning stations will be placed at convenient places along with tissues. Please use these when required and dispose of tidily.

Overall, please be alert to your situation and aware of your surroundings and apply common sense at all times.

Please respect these conditions and the staff and committee members who are trying to make this club work at this strange time. These directions are not negotiable but we will review with formal requests .
